Church Security Arrangements

Following recent events the Church Committee at the last meeting discussed Church Security. They have agreed to have a new lock fitted to the Church front door which will automatically lock when it is closed. Also the door giving access to the corridor leading to the halls will have a new lock fitted. New keys will be issued to those in leadership roles and staff.

The committee also decided that following the morning and evening services the premises should be vacated **THREE QUARTERS OF AN HOUR** after the Church services have ended, when the Church Officer will lock up. On occasions when 'special' services are taking place this deadline can be extended.

It is imperative that all organisations using the Church premises ensure when leaving that all lights are switched off, areas left tidy and doors locked.
