Easter Outreach— thanks to Robert and all his helpers and to those who contributed towards the gift bags—it's wonderful to be able to go out into our community at this time.

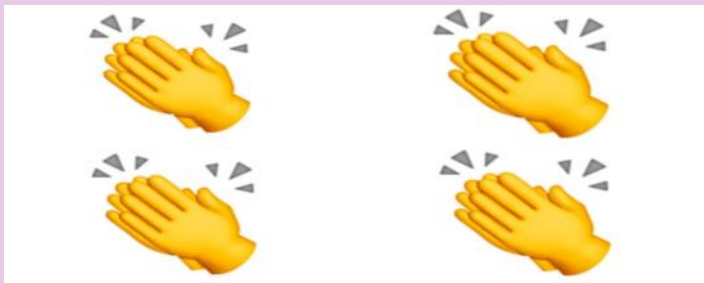
Dawn Service—thanks to Diane and Richard and all their helpers—it's great to be able to welcome other churches to our church for breakfast.
